DIAMONDHEAD WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

October 27, 2022 - 4:00pm (CST)

Diamondhead City Hall - Council Chambers, 5000 Diamondhead Circle, Diamondhead, MS

1. PRESENT BOARD MEMBERS: Chairman Bryon Griffith, Vice-Chairman Ben Taylor, Treasurer Louis Ertel, Commissioner Mark Beisecker, and Commissioner Arlen Griffey.

ABSENT: None.

The presence of a quorum was noted, and the meeting was called to order at 4:02pm. The public was duly notified in compliance with the District's open meeting policy.

Approve Agenda.

Motion by Commissioner Griffey, second by Commissioner Ertel to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Public Comments.

James Moody with Cadence Insurance presented the 2023 Employee Insurance Renewal.

- 4. Minutes.
 - 4.1. <u>Motion by Commissioner Griffey, second by Commissioner Ertel to approve the minutes for the Regular Meeting held on October 13, 2022. Motion carried unanimously.</u> (Attachment A).
- 5. General Manager's Report.
 - 5.1. Update of Recent Events & Projects.
 - **5.1.A.** The larger hydraulic crane arrived Tuesday, October 25, 2022 for the Elevated Water Tank Project. Sections of the tower were lifted on October 26, 2022. The water line feed piping is installed. Lower sections of the bulb are scheduled to begin to be installed soon.
 - **5.1.B.** The contractor is finishing up Section #10, Ala Moana Street, for the Water System Improvement Phase II Project. Crews will be fusing pipe for Section #11, Koloa Street on Friday, October 28, 2022. The crew will be boring and pulling pipe on Section #11, Koloa Street, during the week of October 31, 2022.
 - **5.1.C.** The sandblasting paint removal process for the Water Tower #1 Exterior Painting Project was completed on October 21, 2022. Crews are scheduled to begin priming and painting on October 31, 2022.

- **5.1.D.** The Water System Improvement Phase III Project is 15% complete. The contractor has completed open cut excavation along Hilo Way west to Alawai Avenue. The underground directional drilling crew are working on Hilo Place, Maui Court, and portions of Hilo Way. They will continue boring operations on Alawai Avenue and Diamondhead Drive East. Due to vibration, the boring crew caused a crack in the water main piping on Hilo Place. District staff responded immediately and isolated Hilo Place from surrounding water mains. Following this incident, Diamondhead Water & Sewer District management discovered that additional unapproved sub-contractors were working on the site. District management immediately instructed engineers to vacate these unapproved sub-contractors until the proper approval process was followed as required by the District.
- **5.1.E.** CCTV of the mains is complete for the Sewer Improvements Basins 13, 16, & 17 Project. CCTV of lateral service lines began on October 24, 2022. The contractor is working to complete the replacement section at Hanalei Circle and will be replacing force main concurrently along with gravity sewer to the Diamondhead Drive East intersection. An incident involving a 3-inch secondary water main supplying water to Lift Station #17 on Hanalei Circle was pulled apart after being excavated. District management and staff responded immediately to control the surrounding water mains and isolate impact to only 11 residents. Service was restored as soon as possible.
- **5.1.F.** The District has performed 2 water service line repairs, 1 after hour leak investigation, 1 sewer service backup, 2 sewer service line repairs, installed 5 new residential water/sewer connections, and replaced 3 fire hydrants since the last meeting.
- **5.1.G.** The temporary emergency pipe support and culvert installed by the District at the Kolo Court drainage ditch are holding steady and the culvert is working. The temporary measures are an attempted to prevent further sewer main damage from an eroding ditch bank collapse. There has been no response from the City on their plans for repair since the drawings were sent from Pickering Engineering on August 4, 2022.
